

THE COMPOSITION OF THE LEGISLATURE

The LEGISLATURE has a POLITICAL as well as an ADMINISTRATIVE component.

The POLITICAL component has to consist of between 30 – 80 members according to section 105 (2) of the Constitution.

- The SPEAKER – currently Ms Newrene Klaaste – is the POLITICAL HEAD of the institution.
- Ingevolge art. 111 van die GRONDWET word die SPEAKER deur mede Lede van die Provinsiale Wetgewer (LPW's) verkies.
- The SPEAKER is responsible for the overall management of the Legislature.
- Die SPEAKER tree ook op as voorsittende beampete tydens debatte en sittings.
- Verder moet die SPEAKER orde tydens debatte en sittings handhaaf deur toe te sien dat LPW's ten alle tye die REËLS van die HUIS nakom.
- Sodanige individu moet dus ten alle tye ONPARTYDIG en REDELIK optree.
- Die SPEAKER werk ook nou saam met die SEKRETARIS – tans Mnr. Moopelwa – wat die Rekenpligtige Beampete is, en aan die hoof van die ADMINSTRATIEWE komponent staan.
